## **Helping Companion Animals in 2022**

Thanks to your generous donations, Friends of Pets was able to significantly impact animal welfare in our community this year. Dogs and cats found loving homes, funds to address pet medical and family emergencies were provided, and we continued to provide lifelong care for animals with chronic health problems through the Marjorie Burrows Feldman Fund for Sanctuary Care. A highlight of this past year was the continued expansion of our spay/neuter assistance program.

Through our spay and neuter coupon program, Friends of Pets assisted hundreds of animals get spayed or neutered across the state, preventing thousands of unwanted litters. Through collaborations with partners like the Alaska SPCA, we provided funds for monthly "free" clinics for qualifying pet owners. In addition, we sponsored spay/neuter surgeries for up to 15 animals a month at Anchorage Animal Care and Control.

During this past year we saw a marked increase in requests for Community Emergency Assistance. Your gifts enabled us to assist with emergency health interventions and requests for pet housing, food, and medication during crisis, helping companion animals and families to stay together.

We continue to assist Anchorage Animal Care and Control rescue dogs and cats in need of special assistance to help them find forever homes. We also helped community members who, due to illness, crisis, or owners' death needed assistance rehoming loved animal family members.

Thank you for being there for us, so we could be there for them!

# **President's Report**

As we move forward into 2023, the Board of Friends of Pets remains committed to our vision of helping build communities where companion animals are loved, wanted, and protected. Our focus on prevention, intervention, and education resulted this year in significantly expanding our spay/neuter assistance, continuing our rescue and adoption program, sustaining the Marjorie Burrows Fund for sanctuary care, and providing support to those in crisis in our community who have companion animal family members to house, feed, and provide health care for. We have had a front row seat to the increased distress in our community related to financial insecurity and the impact on companion animals. As a result, we have enhanced support to provide health care or housing "bridges" so

members of our community can retain their loved animal family members. These outcomes would not occur without the incredible support of each of you and your partnership, enabling us to intervene and have a positive impact. Our annual Quilts and Creations silent auction held this fall at the ALoft Hotel, and featured in this newsletter, provided critical funds for our expanding spay/neuter assistance program. The Pick Click Program helps to fund all our programs and we are so grateful for those who choose to give from their PFD. However you choose to give, whether by giving gifts of time, talent, or resources, you are elevating animal welfare in our community.

We are delighted to welcome Erin Reynolds to the Board of Directors. She has been volunteering with Friends of Pets for the past several years as a foster home and member of the spay/neuter committee. Erin brings to the Board a wealth of experience in management of shelter volunteer coordination. She has facilitated the development of foster homes, training programs, and adoption promotion. We are delighted to have her expertise as part of our organizational leadership.

While we are buried in snow, it's hard to believe that spring is just around the corner bringing events such as Reading Rendezvous and Dog Jog but we'll look forward to seeing you there!



## 2022 QUILT auction!

The Quilt Auction was back and our quilt artists were busy during the break! This years Quilt Auction raised almost \$13,000 to help with our Spay and Neuter program.

Focusing on prevention, we have been:

- Promoting our \$100 spay/neuter assistance coupons statewide.
- Providing funding for spay/neuter costs at Anchorage Animal Care and Control for 15 animals a month so more animals are spayed or neutered before leaving the shelter.
- Sponsoring monthly free spay/neuter clinics in partnership with the Alaska SPCA and clinics in the Valley because we understand that the costs of surgery is a barrier for lower income pet owners.

Because reducing the unwanted pet population is critical to animal welfare in our state, we will continue to focus on reducing barriers to affordable spay/neuter surgery. The funds raised during the Quilt Auction go directly to this effort and have tremendous impact.






#### Thanks for the Smiles



# Meet our sanctuary animals... Aspen



Aspen came into our sanctuary program after her former owner transitioned into assisted living. She is a 13-year-old sweetheart who had unmet health care needs. She is now undergoing treatment for Cushing's disease. Wonderful volunteers have agreed to provide her a lifetime sanctuary home, and Friends of Pets will continue to support her health care needs.

## Our sanctuary program

Our rescue program cares for two groups of animals who are with us long-term. Long-term fosters have no particular issues to prohibit adoption, but after one year still have not found a forever match. Sanctuary animals have poor adoption prospects due to old age, medical issues, or other problems, but their quality of life is good and euthanasia is not recommended. Still, the reality is that our commitment to their support diverts both space and finances from other animals who could be saved. We hold hope that each of these special souls may find a loving family of his or her very own. The sanctuary fund also helps support our adoptive families with some medical costs for special needs pets.

# Spay/Neuter Community Assistance Program (Statewide)

If you are an Alaska resident and need financial help to spay or neuter your pet, we can help. We encourage you to apply for our spay/neuter community assistance program which operates year-round. FOP can provide a \$100 coupon to be applied toward the cost of spay/neuter surgery. Request forms and instructions are in the Help & Answers section at <a href="https://www.friendsofpets.org">www.friendsofpets.org</a>. Important! Be sure to read and follow the instructions, and apply <a href="https://www.friendsofpets.org">before</a> you schedule any procedures. You must have the coupon in hand prior to your pet's surgery. This program is funded through the annual Quilts & Creations Auction, and by our donors, to help stop pet overpopulation in Alaska.
